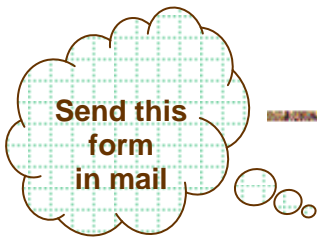

### Dress Code

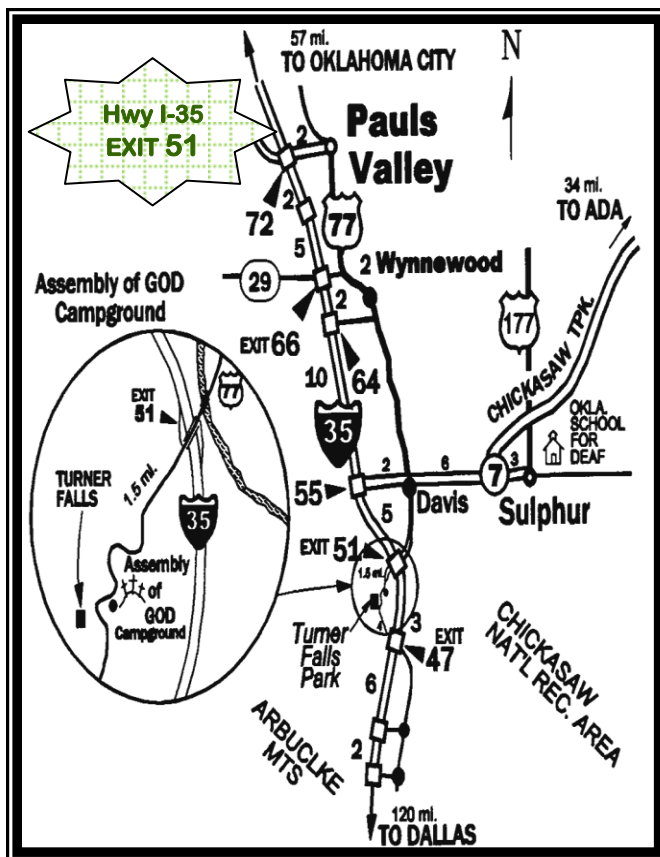
- Casual and modest clothing
